

VILLAGE OF ST. CLOUD BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEETING
MAY 5, 2026 – 7:00 P.M.

FOLLOWING THE PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE, THE REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING OF THE ST. CLOUD VILLAGE BOARD WAS CALLED TO ORDER AT 7:00 P.M BY DAVID SCHRY IN THE ABSENCE OF PRESIDENT ERIC HEIMERMANN.

ALL BOARD MEMBERS WERE PRESENT.

FOLLOWING THE READING OF THE APRIL MEETING MINUTES, DAVE CALLED FOR A MOTION FOR APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES. TOM OETJEN MOTIONED TO APPROVE THE MINUTES; AS READ, SECONDED BY ADAM PUETZ. ALL MEMBERS WERE IN FAVOR AND THE MINUTES WERE APPROVED.

UTILITY:

TONY STEFFEN REPORTED THAT COPPER SAMPLES WERE TAKEN AT THE DISCHARGE AT THE LAGOONS FOR THE PERMIT RENEWAL. SABEL MECHANICAL REPLACED CHECK VALVES AT THE LAGOONS. DNR DRINKING WATER SAMPLES HAVE BEEN TAKEN. WELL #2 HAS BEEN TAKEN OFF-LINE FOR REHAB IN PROGRESS.

LAST YEARS METERS WERE TESTED AND PASSED AND READY TO BE REINSTALLED.

APRIL PUMPAGE REPORT:

726,000 GALLONS WAT PUMPED AND WASTEWATER TREATED:1,497,000

(DIFFERENCE: 771,000 GALLONS).

DNR SAMPLING CONTINUES; WORK IS IN PROGRESS FOR WPDES PERMIT RENEWAL DUE SEPT. 30, 2026.

METER REPLACEMENTS NEEDED AT WELL #3 WILL BE COMPLETED WHEN WELL #2 GOES BACK ON-LINE.

WORK IS IN PROGRESS ON COMPLETING THE PERMIT REQUIREMENTS FOR THE WPDES PERMIT DUE SEPT.30, 2026.

TONY GAVE A SUMMARIZED UPDATE ON THE WELL #2 REHAB PROJECT. WELL PIPING, PUMP AND HEAD SHAFT ARE DETERIORATED AND NEED REPLACEMENT. TELEVISIONING WILL BE DONE TO DETERMINE THE CONDITION OF THE WELL HOLE.

JEFF HAS COMPLETED LAWNMOWER REPAIRS NEEDED. DAVE WILL CHECK WITH NORTHEAST ASPHALT OR FOND DU LAC COUNTY ON ESTIMATED COST OF BLACKTOPPING THE ROAD TO THE LAGOONS FOR EASIER MAINTENANCE.

VILLAGE:

ADAM PUETZ HAS CHECKED INTO SECURITY CAMERA CELLULAR SINGLE PLANS. VERIZON WOULD OFFER \$9.00 A MONTH PLAN, FOR STILL PICTURES, POSSIBLY WITH CAMERAS INCLUDED IN THE COST.

HE WILL FOLLOWUP FOR MORE INFORMATION, INCLUDING A SEPARATE VILLAGE PHONE LINE IN PLACE OF RHONDA'S PERSONAL CELLPHONE.

THE MAY BOARD OF REVIEW MEETING WILL BE POSTPONED UNTIL AUGUST OR SEPTEMBER DUE TO THE REVALUATION OF THE VILLAGE WHICH IS DUE THIS YEAR. THE ASSESSOR WILL BE IN CONTACT ON A DATE AND TIME WHEN VALUE NUMBERS ARE IN PLACE.

TOM OETJEN HAS PLANNED TO MEET WITH MELISSA BINK TO GO OVER THE WEBSITE POSTING JOB.

QUOTES FOR GARBAGE & RECYCLING PICKUP IN THE VILLAGE WILL BE OBTAINED FROM THREE CONTRACTORS TO BEGIN CONTRACT IN JANUARY, 2027.

THE TENTATIVE MAY 23 ROAD PLANNING MEETING WITH MIKE BORN WAS DISCUSSED. CHUCK PIERQUET, ADAM PUETZ, TOM OETJEN, AND LAURIE SIPPEL HAVE OFFERED TO BE AVAILABLE FOR THE MEETING. CHUCK WILL CONTACT MIKE BORN TO CONFIRM A TIME.

COMMITTEES:

ADAM PUETZ CHECKED INTO NEEDED REPAIRS OF THE VILLAGE PARK PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT AND SEVERAL REPAIRS AND/OR REPLACEMENTS ARE NEEDED. ADAM WILL CONTACT BURKE PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT TO COME OUT TO CHECK OUT WHAT ALL NEEDS TO BE DONE.

CHUCK GAVE A REMINDER ON FOLLOW-UPS ON SIDEWALK REPLACEMENT/REPAIRS THAT WERE TO BE COMPLETED IN JUNE 2026. THERE WILL BE FURTHER DISCUSSION REGARDING THIS AT THE JUNE 2 BOARD MEETING.

OTHER COMMITTEE REPORTING WAS COVERED EARLIER IN THE MEETING.

DAVE CALLED FOR A MOTION TO PAY BILLS AND REVIEW TIMECARDS. JARED BERENZ MOTIONED TO PAY BILLS; SECONDED BY TOM OETJEN. BILLS WERE PAID AND TIMECARDS WERE REVIEWED AND APPROVED.

TOM OETJEN MOTIONED TO ADJOURN THE MEETING; ADAM PUETZ SECONDED THE MOTION. THE MEETING ADJOURNED AT 8:00 P.M.
